Travel

Life in Detroit and Michigan

- Resident Living Arrangements
 - About 1/3 of residents reside downtown
 - About 1/3 of residents reside in Royal Oak area (north of Detroit via I-75 or Woodward Avenue and roughly a 30 minute ride)
 - About 1/3 of residents are in other surrounding cities (varies in distance to DMC but generally 15-30 minutes)
- Michigan Travel
 - Many hiking trails and other outdoor activities
 - Northern Michigan before Mackinac Bridge is about a 4-5 hour drive to anywhere in Lower Peninsula






