Application Service and Process for Recruitment

The General Surgery Residency at Detroit Medical Center/Wayne State University will utilize the following services during recruitment season.

Applications for Main Residency Match

ERAS (Electronic Residency Application System), will be used exclusively for all initial applications for a residency in General Surgery. This applies to both Categorical and Preliminary positions.

Applications for SOAP (Supplemental Offer and Acceptance Program)

ERAS (Electronic Residency Application System), will be used exclusively for all SOAP applications for a residency in General Surgery. This applies to both Categorical and Preliminary positions.

Interview Invitation

Any applicant to the general surgery program selected by program leadership to interview with the program will be invited through the Thalamus interview program. This applies to both Categorical and Preliminary positions.

Actual Interview

The program will exclusively perform interviews via the Zoom Platform. There are no in-person activities planned for applicants.

Matching Algorithm

The residency will utilize the NRMP (National Resident Matching Program) for all residency positions. This applies to both Categorical and Preliminary positions.

Steps of Recruitment:

1. Applicant applies to program via ERAS
2. Program Leadership reviews all applications and selects those to invite to interview
3. An interview invitation is sent to the selected applicants through Thalamus email system
4. Applicant signs up or declines an interview in the Thalamus system
5. The program organizes a Zoom interview
6. Interviews are conducted
7. The program submits a match rank list in the NRMP R3® System (National Resident Matching System Registration, Ranking, and Results system)
8. The applicant submits a match rank list in the NRMP R3® System (National Resident Matching System Registration, Ranking, and Results system)
9. Match algorithm occurs through NRMP
10. Program reaches out to matched individuals and begins onboarding process
