

Guidelines for Trauma Patient Receiving Tranexamic Acid (TXA) from Pre-Hospital Provider

- 1. Upon patient's arrival to resuscitation primary assessment will be initiated.
- 2. Source of bleeding identified and blood products administered as deemed appropriate.
- 3. The patient may need to go to the OR for bleeding control.
- 4. The decision to administer the second dose of TXA will be determined by the attending surgeon.
- 5. TEG6s global hemostasis with LYSIS, <u>must</u> be ordered in the ED as part of initial laboratory works.
- 6. Consider using TXA only if when TEG lysis is elevated

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
